



Dermatological test of Dryarn polypropylene

Research conducted at the Dermatological Clinic of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia granted Dryarn polypropylene the Dermatologically Tested certificate, making it the only fiber on the market to obtain this certification.

The study was carried out on a sample of approximately 300 volunteers with sensitive skin, through three main phases during which males and females above the age of 18 underwent several skin tests to evaluate any possible allergies caused by contact with Dryarn. Volunteers were requested to wear clothing produced exclusively in Dryarn night and day for one month to study the effects of Dryarn evaluating ailments such as erythema, xerosis (dry skin), vesiculation and desquamation. Results were excellent. This is the first time that a synthetic fiber passed such a rigorous examination and justly takes its place on the podium until now reserved for the natural fiber par excellence: cotton. Even people suffering from serious problems, in the past advised to wear only undyed "natural" cotton, can wear clothes made of Dryarn which, already colored in origin (batch dyeing), has been tested in all its colors and approved for its tolerability, hypoallergenic features and breathability.
